Capacity building of Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA) as the front line workers for community mobilization is an important intervention under NRHM in which training in Module 6 & 7 has its importance for reducing Infant Mortality Rate, Maternal Mortality Rate, malnutrition and detection & treatment of malaria, tuberculosis cases. For the purpose of implementing training of ASHA in Module 6 & 7, respective District Health Societies has selected and approved the NGOs listed below through open advertisement.
